I think the new version is very good. Works as described. I like the idea that it is updating data resources and as we move forward we can hopefully see better resolution of health conditions such as hypertension and diabetes from OSHPD and the developing HIE networks. I understand the limitation of the tool is more a function of available data rather than some kind of failure on CPDH's part.

In the future I would love to see a feature that allow ground truthing reports to be added as a layer. This would involve creating an sysadmin who could verify and enter the data from various organizations working in our communities across the state. It would also require creation of a training and certification program for community groups that wanted to collect and enter information. This would provide a true "test" of the systems existing data and be able to connect the exposures to the impacts on the ground.
