ARTICLE 5. Extent of Exposure

New § 25501.1 Naturally Occurring Concentrations of Listed Chemicals in Unprocessed Foods

(a) For purposes of Section 25501(a)(2), the following levels of chemicals in food are deemed to be naturally occurring.

<u>Chemical</u>	<u>Food</u>	<u>Concentration (parts per billion)</u>
<u>Inorganic arsenic</u>	<u>White rice grain</u>	<u>60</u>
	<u>Brown rice grain</u>	<u>130</u>
<u>Lead</u>	<u>Raw leafy vegetables</u>	<u>8.8</u>
	<u>Raw non-leafy vegetables, fruit, meat, seafood, eggs, and fresh milk</u>	<u>6.2</u>
