Thanks for the discussion yesterday. As a follow-up, you requested that I send you electronic copies of the EPA's recent Federal Register on chlorsulfuron (in which the Agency concludes that chlorsulfuron is not a developmental or reproductive toxicant – but does keep chlorsulfuron on the TRI list due to a single criteria: toxicity to aquatic plants).

I have attached the FR as published, plus a full page version of the same document, with the conclusions highlighted in yellow. I have also attached the slide deck that I used for our discussion yesterday.

Again, the question is, does the delisting action by OEHHA, based on 27 CCR 25306(j)(2) ["The chemical is no longer identified as causing cancer or reproductive toxicity by the authoritative body."] need to go through the DART-IC for concurrence?
