SECTION 25705 – SPECIFIC REGULATORY LEVELS
POSING NO SIGNIFICANT RISK

NO SIGNIFICANT RISK LEVEL: CHLOROTHALONIL

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) amended the proposed No Significant Risk Level (NSRL) for chlorothalonil and modified the technical support document to apply the new scaling factor that was adopted recently in Section 25703(a)(6) of Title 27, California Code of Regulations. The new scaling factor increased the value of the NSRL for chlorothalonil from 27 micrograms per day to 41 micrograms per day. There have been no other changes in the laws related to the proposed regulations or to the effect of the proposed regulations from the laws and effects described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.
