

UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST
22 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS

OEHHA has revised the no significant risk level for the chemical di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP) from the initially proposed level of 300 micrograms per day to 310 micrograms per day. OEHHA also defers the proposed adoption of the maximum allowable daily level (MADL) for arsenic. Comments for arsenic were of a nature that precludes the adoption of the regulatory level for that chemical at this time. OEHHA intends to promulgate a regulatory level for arsenic at a later date. There have been no other changes in the laws related to the proposed regulations or to the effect of the proposed regulations from the laws and effects described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.
