I am writing on behalf of Clean Water Action and our over 50,000 California members in support of OEHHA's efforts to ensure that all Californians have more useful information about toxic chemical exposures. We especially support an accessible website as an effective way to disseminate such information to consumers.

Information about chemical exposures is not only a basic human right, it is a cost effective way to prevent or limit the impacts of that exposure and avoid the medical or social expenses that can result. Consequently, we disagree with the argument that establishing a website, as described in OEHHA's proposed regulation, is overly expensive.
