Subject: Reconsideration of Nine Chemicals Listed under Proposition 65 as Known to Cause Reproductive Toxicity. Chemicals Listed via the Labor Code Mechanism: Ethyl-tert-butyl ether (ETBE)

Dear Ms. Oshita,

This email is a follow-up to the written submission to OEHHA from Dr. Marcy Banton of Lyondell Chemical Company dated November 1 that contained comments on ETBE. Dr. Banton mentioned a number of relevant published and unpublished reports on ETBE that were not included in the draft Hazard Identification Document (HID). In order to ensure that the DARTIC members have access to all of the available information for ETBE, I request you to provide the DARTIC members with a copy of the de Peyster (2010) publication (see citation below), which reviews all of the available studies, including the unpublished studies. Although this article was not mentioned in the HID, I assume that OEHHA has ready access to this publication, but if this is not the case, please let me know. Thank you.
