Some comments with your food labels:

- Manufacturers must print the date when they manufactured their products and not only print the date when the product is good (expiration date). This will be a double check and a process specialist (i.e., food processing specialist) must corroborate how long these products can stay on the shelf.
- Labels containing the main ingredients and the expiration date must have a specified font: Most of the time you need a magnifying lens to read the contents.
