Chemicals For Which Testing Has Not Been
Adequately Tested as Required –
To Be Added to the List
(for Reproductive Toxicity Testing)**

As reported by the US EPA:

- Acetaldehyde
- Alkenes, C₁₂₋₂₄, chloro
- Benzenediamine, ar,ar-diethyl-ar-methyl-
- Benzenesulfonyl chloride
- 1H,3H-Benzo[1,2-c:4,5-c']difuran-1,3,5,7-tetrone
- C.I. Leuco Sulphur Black 1
- Castor oil, sulfated, sodium salt
- Castor oil, oxidized



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As reported by the US EPA: (continued)

- D-gluco-heptonic acid, monosodium salt, (2.xi.)-
- Ethanedioic acid
- Ethylene dichloride
- 2,4-Hexadienoic acid, (E,E)-
- Hydrocarbons, C>4
- 3-Nitrobenzenesulfonic acid, sodium salt
- Phosphorochloridothioic acid, O,O-diethyl ester
- 1,1'-Oxybis[2,chloro-ethane]



Title 27, Cal. Code Regs, Section 27000 Chemicals For Which Testing is Satisfied – *To Be Removed From the List*

As reported by the Department of Pesticide Regulation:

- Methyl isothiocyanate
- Polyethoxy polypropoxy polyethoxy ethanol
– iodine complex
- Sabadilla alkaloids

As reported by the US EPA:

- 1,1,2-Trichloroethane
- Benzisothio styrene
- Maneb with ETU

(removed for reproductive toxicity, remains for teratogenicity)
