Article 2, Section 25205

Lead Agency Website

- Website will be developed and maintained by OEHHA
- Website will provide the public information regarding chemicals, exposures, ways to minimize exposures, and other key information
- OEHHA to establish a process for a person to request correction of material provided on website
- Any person may provide the lead agency with information to be considered for posting on the website



Article 2, Section 25205 Lead Agency Website

- OEHHA may request product information from a business, manufacturer, producer, distributor, or importer
- Includes process to request that certain information provided to OEHHA be protected as Confidential Business Information (“CBI”)
- Compliance with the regulation does not satisfy the “clear and reasonable” warning requirement; failure to comply with the regulation is not a violation of the warning requirements

Lead Agency Website

Information to be provided on website

- Information regarding exposures to listed chemicals, including common routes or pathways of exposure
- Strategies for reducing or avoiding exposure to listed chemicals
- Links to information compiled by other authoritative entities
- Reasonably available information concerning the anticipated level of human exposure to listed chemicals
