To Esther Barajas-Ochoa of CA OEHAA:

The current "safe" level of glyphosate being considered is absurd. There is NO SAFE LEVEL of poison on our food and exposure to our families. The Cal EPA OEHHA is proposing a level thousands of times higher than PROVEN to cause liver disease which is a precursor to cancer and millions of times higher than shown to stimulate the growth of breast cancer cells. It is 2.2 times higher than American children are already being exposed to and nearly 6 times higher than the EPA allows. The amount does not take into consideration a fetus, baby or child, their development and their vulnerable immune systems. It does not take into consideration exposure from farm, parks, playgrounds, landscaping drift or direct contact. Glyphosate is never used alone, and yet the assessment is only for glyphosate, not glyphosate herbicides, which contain toxins that are 1000X more toxic. And the OEHHA team did not review epidemiology studies as is required by Code of Regulation 25703. Please do the right thing for the health of Americans everywhere, and ban glyphosate today. At the very least, foods containing glyphosate must be labeled. We have the right to know if we are feeding this toxic weedkiller to our children. Americans in every state are watching and waiting to see if CA EPA will do the right thing and stand up for the health of consumers, or bow to pressure from Monsanto.
