Eating fish with higher levels of chemicals like mercury or PCBs may cause health problems in children and adults.



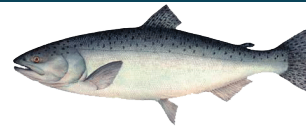
Choose the Right Fish
