CORRECTION TO THE LIST OF CHEMICALS
AS KNOWN TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
TO CAUSE CANCER OR REPRODUCTIVE TOXICITY

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) is making a correction to the list of chemicals as known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity which was published on **June 6, 2003** in the California Regulatory Notice Register (Register 03, No. 23-Z). The chemical, *erionite*, was listed on October 1, 1988 as a chemical known to the State to cause cancer with a Chemical Abstract Service (CAS) number of 12510-42-8. It was recently brought to OEHHA's attention that there is an additional CAS number, 66733-21-9, assigned to the chemical *erionite*. Accordingly for clarification, the chemical *erionite* is listed with two CAS numbers as a chemical known to the State to cause cancer.
