SPECIFIC REGULATORY LEVELS POSING NO SIGNIFICANT RISK ETHYLENE OXIDE

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) is giving notice, pursuant to Government Code Section 11347, that it has decided not to proceed with the rulemaking action published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 7, 2023, Register 2023, No.14-Z. The proposed rulemaking intended to update the No Significant Risk Level for Ethylene Oxide (OAL File No. Z2023-0328-01).

Under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), a rulemaking must be completed within one-year of the date it was first noticed to the public. OEHHA has determined that additional time is required to complete the rulemaking process and is withdrawing the rulemaking. OEHHA intends to restart the rulemaking process at a later time. Public notice and an opportunity to comment on that proposal will be provided.
