**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND EXTENSION OF THE
COMMENT PERIOD**

April 23, 2021

On March 19, 2021, the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) proposed amendments to Article 6, Clear and Reasonable warnings under Proposition 65¹, by adopting tailored safe harbor warnings for cannabis (marijuana) smoke and delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol (delta-9-THC) exposures. The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for the proposed amendments was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on March 19, 2021 (Z-2021-0309-06) and initiated a 60-day public comment period. OEHHA has received a request from Katchko, Vitiello & Karikomi, PC to hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments.

OEHHA has scheduled a public hearing on May 10, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. In accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Orders N-29-20 and N-33-20, as well as recommendations from the California Department of Public Health, the hearing will not have a physical location and will be conducted remotely. Information concerning how to participate in the hearing will be posted on our website prior to the hearing. The public comment period for this regulatory action is being extended to May 24, 2021, to accommodate the hearing.
