EXPOSURES)

NOTICE OF ADOPTION

October 26, 2023

On October 3, 2023, the Office of Administrative Law approved the amendment of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 25705, to add a No Significant Risk Level (NSRL) for antimony trioxide. **The regulation will be effective on January 1, 2024.** This regulation establishes an NSRL of 0.13 micrograms per day for antimony trioxide by the inhalation route.
