Safe Harbor Warnings for Cannabis (Marijuana) Smoke and delta-9-Tetrahydrocannabinol (delta-9-THC) Exposure	Adopted, effective October 1, 2022	
Safe Harbor Warning Regulation for Exposures to Glyphosate from Consumer Products	Adopted, effective January 1, 2023	
Safe Harbor Warning Regulation for Exposures to Acrylamide in Food	Submitted to Office of Administrative Law	
Exposures to Acrylamide in Cooked and Heat Processed Foods	Out for public review and comment
