

UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST  
22 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopts the regulatory levels for the chemical di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP) by intravenous (i.v.) injection. On June 25, 2005, OEHHA published a Notice of Modifications to Text of Regulations, proposing two new Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADLs) for DEHP for exposure by intravenous injection specifically for infant boys and neonatal boys. There have been no other changes in the laws related to the proposed regulations or to the effect of the proposed regulations from the laws and effects described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.
