NO SIGNIFICANT RISK LEVEL FOR VINYLIDENE CHLORIDE**

**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT**

**May 17, 2018**

On May 9, 2018, the Office of Administrative Law approved the amendment of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, section 25705, No Significant Risk Level (NSRL) for the chemical vinylidene chloride. **The regulation will be effective on July 1, 2018.** This regulation establishes a No Significant Risk Level of 0.88 micrograms per day for vinylidene chloride for purposes of Proposition 65.<sup>1</sup>
