NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES

CHEMICALS TO BE LISTED EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1992 AS KNOWN TO THE STATE TO CAUSE CANCER OR REPRODUCTIVE TOXICITY

The California Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment has identified 24 chemicals for listing under the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) as known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. These chemicals will be listed effective October 1, 1992.

The chemicals and their Chemical Abstracts Services Registry (CAS) numbers are listed below. All the chemicals were listed administratively, based on either: (1) a formal requirement by a State or federal agency that the chemical be labeled or identified as causing cancer or reproductive toxicity (chemicals so listed are designated with an "FR"); or (2) a formal identification of a chemical as a carcinogen or reproductive toxicant by an "authoritative body" ("AB"). These listing mechanisms are addressed in Title 22, California Code of Regulations, Sections 12902 and 12306, respectively.

A complete, updated chemical list is published elsewhere in this issue of the Register.
