EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED PUBLIC HEALTH GOALS FOR PERFLUOROOCTANOIC ACID (PFOA) AND PERFLUOROOCTANE SULFONIC ACID (PFOS) IN DRINKING WATER

September 9, 2021

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) of the California Environmental Protection Agency is extending the public comment period on the draft technical support document for proposed Public Health Goals (PHGs) for perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS) in drinking water. The comment period will now close on October 28, 2021. This extends by 30 days the public comment period that was initiated on July 30, 2021.

OEHHA is extending the public comment period at the request of the American Chemistry Council.

As previously announced, OEHHA is holding a virtual public workshop on the draft document on September 28, 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. or until business is concluded, whichever occurs first.
