AMENDMENT TO SECTION 25705(c)(2)

SPECIFIC REGULATORY LEVELS POSING NO SIGNIFICANT RISK:

TITANIUM DIOXIDE (AIRBORNE, UNBOUND PARTICLES OF RESPIRABLE SIZE)

A Notice of proposed rulemaking to adopt a Proposition 65 No Significant Risk Level (NSRL) for titanium dioxide (airborne, unbound particles of respirable size) by amending Title 27, California Code of Regulations, section 25705(c)(2) was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register (Z-2024-0430-08) on May 10, 2024. OEHHA proposed an NSRL of 440 micrograms per day for airborne, unbound titanium dioxide particles with diameters of 10 micrometers or less, and an NSRL of 44 micrograms per day for airborne, unbound titanium dioxide particles with diameters of 0.8 micrometers or less. The notice initiated a 45-day public comment period that was scheduled to close on June 24, 2024.

At the request of the Personal Care Products Council and the American Chemistry Council, OEHHA hereby extends the public comment period. The comment period will now close on **Monday, July 1, 2024**.

All written comments must be submitted to OEHHA by electronic submission, mail, or hand-delivery, by July 1, 2024, as indicated below. OEHHA strongly recommends that comments be submitted electronically through our website at <https://oehha.ca.gov/comments> rather than in paper form.
