

## Summary of 2025 DARTIC Meeting

A meeting of the DARTIC was held on October 9, 2025, starting at 10:00 am. During the meeting, OEHHA staff presented a summary of evidence on the developmental toxicity of bisphenol S (BPS). This was followed by a discussion and deliberation on the evidence by the DARTIC. The DARTIC then determined that BPS was clearly shown, through scientifically valid testing according to generally accepted principles, to cause developmental toxicity by a vote of 6 (yes) to 2 (no). [BPS was first placed on the Proposition 65 list for reproductive toxicity](#), based on the female reproductive endpoint, on December 29, 2023, and based on the male reproductive endpoint on January 3, 2025.

Ahead of the meeting, OEHHA had issued a [request for relevant information on the potential reproductive toxicity of BPS](#), which opened on March 4, 2022 and closed on April 18, 2022. The data call-in was followed by publication of the hazard identification document entitled “[Evidence on the Developmental Toxicity of Bisphenol S](#)” and a public comment period from July 25, 2025 to September 8, 2025.

OEHHA presented to the DARTIC a proposal for development of hazard identification materials on p,p'-bisphenol chemicals, to support consideration for listing by the DARTIC at a future meeting. DARTIC members discussed the proposal. Finally, OEHHA staff presented updates on chemical listings, safe harbor levels, and other regulations and litigation since the last DARTIC meeting.
