

# What to do if you spill pesticides on your clothes or shoes



**Take them off right away**



**Wash skin with soap and water**



**Keep contaminated items outside in a sealed plastic bag until you can wash them**



**If clothes are lightly contaminated**  
wash separately with hot water and detergent



**If clothes got soaked with pesticides**  
Take them to a household hazardous waste site or ask your employer how to dispose of them safely



**It's best to replace shoes that can't be cleaned with soap and water, such as leather boots**
