**AIR TOXICS HOT SPOTS PROGRAM
AMENDMENT TO NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND WORKSHOPS
ON A DRAFT CANCER INHALATION UNIT RISK FACTOR FOR ACROLEIN**

MAY 29, 2026

On May 14, 2026, the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) released a draft document for public review that summarizes the carcinogenicity data and derives a cancer inhalation unit risk factor (IUR) for acrolein and initiated a 45-day public comment period that was scheduled to end on June 29, 2026.

At the request of interested parties, OEHHA hereby extends the public comment period. **The public comment period will now close on Wednesday, July 29, 2026.** After the close of the public comment period, the draft document may be revised as appropriate by OEHHA and will be peer reviewed by the state's Scientific Review Panel on Toxic Air Contaminants at a later meeting.

OEHHA is also updating information regarding a Central California public workshop. The complete workshop information is now listed below.
