Proposition 65: Pre-Regulatory Workshop

Omnibus 2026

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) will hold a pre-regulatory workshop to discuss potential amendments to Proposition 65 regulations on July 30, 2026. This public meeting will be held in-person and online from 10:00 am to 11:30 am PST, or until all business is conducted. The workshop will include a discussion of potential regulatory amendments that OEHHA will publish on its website prior to the workshop.

Workshop Registration and Oral Comment Instructions

Attendees can participate in the meeting at the CalEPA Training Room 1 East/West on the 1st Floor of the California Environmental Protection Agency's Headquarters building, 1001 I Street, Sacramento, CA, or via Zoom webinar.

For Zoom Webinar attendees, we encourage advance registration and request that registered attendees join the webinar at least 5 minutes before the 10:00 am meeting start time. However, registration will not close until the meeting has adjourned. Note that you do not have to enter your actual name or personal information during registration; for example, you could use initials instead.

If you wish to provide in-person oral public comments at the workshop, you can join the discussion in person in Training Room 1.
