

**ADDENDUM TO
FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**AMENDMENT TO SECTION 25805
SPECIFIC REGULATORY LEVELS: CHEMICALS CAUSING
REPRODUCTIVE TOXICITY**

MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE DOSE LEVEL: SULFUR DIOXIDE

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) omitted to include the modified regulatory text showing the strikeout and underline of the changes made to the originally proposed maximum allowable dose level (MADL) for the chemical sulfur dioxide in the mailing of the Notice of Revision of Proposed Specific Regulatory Level and Augmentation of Record for Proposed Regulation. As required by Government Code Section 11346.8(c), OEHHA should have mailed out the modified regulatory text with changes clearly indicated in strikeout and underline to interested parties, but instead it made an error in omitting the inclusion of the revised regulatory text in the mailing of the Notice of Revision on March 22, 2013. The Notice of Revision of Proposed Specific Regulatory Level and Augmentation of Record was clear and detailed and did not leave anything out as far as explaining the modification made to the originally proposed regulatory text.
