In response to Resilient Floor Covering Institute's (RFCI) request on behalf of its member companies, the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) is issuing the following safe use determination for professional flooring installer exposures to diisononyl phthalate (DINP) in vinyl flooring products, pursuant to our authority under Title 27 of the Cal. Code of Regs., section 25204(h)(1):

 OEHHA is issuing a safe use determination for DINP exposures to professional vinyl flooring installers from vinyl flooring products containing 8.7% DINP by weight, or less.
