

# HUMAN RIGHT TO WATER COMMUNITY WORKSHOP



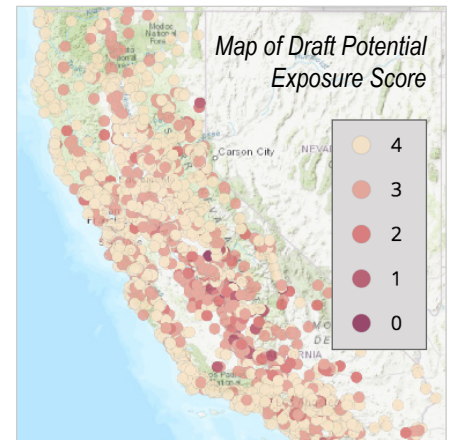
## Hosted by the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment
