

HUMAN RIGHT TO WATER COMMUNITY WORKSHOP



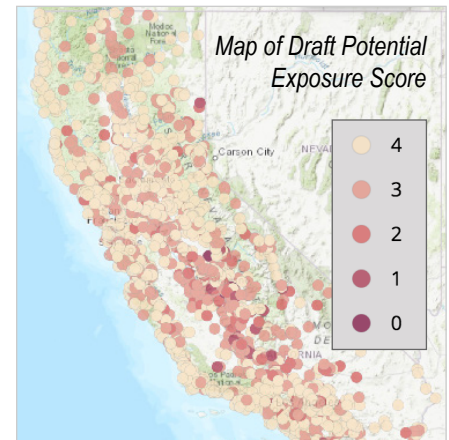
Hosted by the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment
